Safety Summit Recap & FestComm/Safety Cluster (45 min) [6:20]

- Go over items from Talena's notes
 - Should we instead work on defining roles in a clear way instead of discussing what went wrong?
 - Is it clear to everyone what each group does? It seems like no.
 Information is there but people haven't taken initiative to read it.
 - Create a sheet that says "I have read these items (check) (check)" for leadership folks to all complete.
 - Dan to take lead, Frank to assist.
 - Educate planning list
 - https://www.fireflyartscollective.org/firefly-arts-collective/committees/
 - Include in item above.
 - Everyone in this room should be taking <u>ICS classes</u> up to 400. Level 100 is for very ground level but everyone here could be called upon for a managerial level decision during an emergency/incident. (Seth suggests <u>IS-15</u> as well.)
 - Email to the planning list including information on this.
 - 100 and 200 level is available online. 200 covers some management. 300 better for management.
 - Kevin will compile information and send it over.

- We should name FestComm/ people in the chain of command as officers for coverage under our insurance.
 - Note that it's limited in what it covers.
 - Frank to lead, Jered to assist.
- Fire will author a message about unplanned burns being bad. (no specific mention of goats.)
 - Talena and Drama will co-author statement.
- Board would be the group to go look for the perpetrator of the goat burn. Safety can provide some information from their investigation.
 - Will be asking specific persons not the community at large.
 - Jered has information that Kevin sent over regarding their after action findings (and will be shared with the Board).
 - Frank, Gougey, Liz to take next steps.
- Discuss Safety Cluster leadership (rangers, fire, sanctuary, first aid)
 - Jess
 - Not Ranger lead this year.
 - Has expressed interest in Sanctuary.
 - Seth
 - Stepped down as lead. Gap in Fire Core.
 - Unlikely to attend this year
 - ConComm investigation to continue separately.
 - Ranger lead
 - In flux- Probably Kevin
 - Elected by other rangers
 - Festival committee generally on top of looking out for filling gaps
 - First planning meeting in early April.
 - Sanctuary: see notes below
- Radio overhaul
 - Drama says re: rental: For 80 digital radios with chargers, spare batteries, and a repeater it would cost about \$3k. (includes insurance) This does not include shipping.
 - Board supports this.
 - We have an amount of digital radios that were purchased
 - Kevin is working on making radio core more transparent.
 - Blake will follow up with Kevin.
- Outside medical
 - Update from Kevin:
 - First quote: 9 days of coverage: 2 people alternating 12 hour shifts, unclear on if it includes supplies.
 - Will be getting another quote and more details on this one[^]
 - Kevin recommends a defibrillator onsite. Can buy one for around \$1000.
 - Can have something by planning meeting in April.
 - How does it integrate with our volunteers?

- Still have a first aid core that interfaces with the EMTs
- Status of afterburn report
 - Asking festcomm to prepare
 - Tarn will start the process.
 - Contents:
 - Numbers, updates on what worked well, what didn't
- Discussion about Sanctuary
 - Needs to scale back to chill hang out, not ad hoc mental health clinic.
 - Needs clear definition.
 - Looking for a lead: empathetic and organizationally solid. (per Kevin)
 - Should fall to Safety and Festival Committee
